### WHAT ARE 'COOKIES'?

'Cookies' are small text files that are stored by the browser on your computer or mobile phone. They allow websites to store user preferences. You can think of cookies as providing a 'memory' for the website, so that it can recognise you when you come back and respond appropriately.

### HOW WE USE THEM

We use Google Analytics on our website to collect information about your online activity on our Website, such as the pages you visit, the links you click. We use the information to compile reports and to help us improve the website.

The cookies collect information in an anonymous form, including the number of visitors to our website, where visitors have come to the site from and pages they visited. The information generated by those cookies and your current IP Address will be transmitted by your browser to and will be stored by Google Servers.
